Joint ticket and catering offer

- Offer only available to groups of 10 or more people. To qualify for the exhibition group rate, all visitors must be paying an entrance fee. Maximum group size for **Fashion on the Ration** entering the exhibition at any one time is 35.
- All groups must book in advance, pay in advance as one transaction and arrive and enter the exhibition and visit the Tea Room together.
- Group bookings are subject to availability and we may not be able to accommodate groups during busy times such as during school holidays or on weekends.
- Payment must be made in full at the time of booking (credit/debit card only). We are not able to accept payment on arrival. Payment is non-refundable. Numbers cannot be altered after payment has been taken.
- Groups must stipulate the numbers in their group at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee availability for any additional people above the numbers originally included on the booking. Any additional people who arrive on the day will be charged at the full (non offer) rate (for both the exhibition and catering). It will be the responsibility of the additional group members to arrange this individually with the IWM box office and our caterers Peyton and Byrne on the day.
- Groups must arrive by their designated time and enter the exhibition together as one group. We regret we may not be able to admit groups to the exhibition if they are more than 15 minutes late.
