



11th Annual IWM Film Festival

Festival Screenings: 28 November 2011 to 24 February 2012

The 11th Annual IWM Film Festival showcases some of the most imaginative and thought-provoking short-films being made by young and aspiring filmmakers, inspired by our collections and exhibitions and using footage from our industry-respected film archive.

A UK-wide call for entries in 2011 generated over forty new titles, showcasing new and emerging student filmmaking talent. Twenty-seven of these films were accepted for public screening in the cinema at IWM London and entry into the Festival's competition. The Festival will run from Friday 2nd December to Friday 24th February. A schedule of the Festival screenings is below.

An audience poll will shortlist the films to be judged by a panel of industry experts, with the winners announced at the 11th Annual IWM Film Festival Awards, held at IWM London on 13 March 2012.

Each film will be short-listed into one of three categories:

- Annie Dodds Award for Best Documentary
- Best Imaginative Response to the Subject of War
- Winner of the IWM Film Festival Audience Poll

About the IWM Film Festival

The Festival was created to engage aspiring young filmmakers in some of the issues that concern IWM and promote a more responsible and sensitive use of IWM archive footage in historical documentaries. Over the last 11 years it has given a wider audience the opportunity to see some of the interesting and imaginative films being made by student and amateur film makers, contributing to the professional training of young film and television producers and generating greater awareness of the our Film Archive among the general public.

Film Festival Competition

Every year we ask student and amateur filmmakers to take part in the festival and enter the competition. Entrants are short-listed and the most inspiring projects are provided with cinema time at IWM London. An audience poll decides on the films that will be taken to judging by industry-experts, providing contacts and awareness in a competitive industry.

About Annie Dodds

The best documentary award is dedicated to the memory of Annie Dodds, a highly respected filmmaker who was one of the producers of the audiovisuals made for The Holocaust Exhibition and Crimes against humanity. Following Annie's untimely death in 2005, her partner, Chris Wight, approached IWM to establish a permanent memorial to her work and life. It was agreed that associating Annie Dodds's work with the documentary category of the IWM Annual Film Festival would be a most appropriate way of doing this. Sadly, Chris Wight died in September 2007. We are very grateful for the support he gave the Festival during the last year of his life.

The Annie Dodds Award for the Best Documentary is sponsored by October Films.

11th Annual IWM Film Festival Awards Ceremony

The 11th Annual IWM Film Festival Awards winners will be announced on 13 March 2012. The winners are chosen by an audience ballot and a select panel of industry-judges. Awards will be made on the night in three categories: Annie Dodds Award for Best Documentary; Best Imaginative Response to the Subject of War and Winner of the Audience Poll.
