WINE LIST

There are crowd pleasers, award winners and obscurities. Wines with stories and wines with soul. Wines that people will remember... Although someone once said, if you can remember the wine the following day – you didn't drink enough of it.

SPARKLING

Cava Reserva Brut NV, Castillo de Montblanc, Catalonia, Spain

Lively and balanced in the mouth. Full pleasant, crisp, with a well-balanced finish. Delicious!

Prosecco Jeio Brut NV, Valdobbiadene, Veneto, Italy

A classic Prosecco with a fine mousse and a fresh green pear character. Soft and pillowy on the palate with a lingering finish.

Abrau Durso Cuvée Alexander II, Novorossiysk, Russia, NV

Founded by the Tsar of Russia in 1870, this estate has always been at the cutting edge of Russian wine production, The nose shows a subtle combination of green apple, lime and mint, while the palate is fresh, harmonious and predominantly fruity, with a long and satisfying mineral finish.

SPARKLING ROSE

Jeio Rosé, Veneto, Italy NV

Delicate pink colour with fine and persistent bubbles. Elegant and complex nose with rose notes, hints of fresh fruit, citrus and lychees. Harmonious and persistent with a dry and long lasting finish.

Graham Beck Rosé, Robertson, South Africa NV

Pale silver-pink. Aromas of raspberries cherries and a few secondary whiffs of minerality. A lively mousse but fine in the mouth with subtle red berry flavours enlivened by bright acids. Brisk on the palate showing hints of oyster shell and fresh lavender.

ENGLISH SPARKLING

Chapel Down, Vintage Reserve Brut, Kent, England

Subtle aromas of strawberry and cream followed by an elegant palate with hints of wild strawberry and a mouth-watering finish.

Primrose Hill from Chapel Down Brut NV

The wine is rich yet refreshing with both breadth and finesse - stylish but dangerously gluggable.

NON VINTAGE CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Testulat Blanc de Blancs NV

Light and subtle with notes of apple and quince; crisp and well-balanced in the mouth, with delicate bubbles and true blanc de blancs purity.

Champagne Charles Heidsieck NV

Radiant pale gold with fine, persistent bubbles. Complex pastry aromas, with an opulent combination of ripe apricot, mango and greengages, dried fruits, pistachio and almond. The palate begins with a silky smooth sensation, developing into ripe fleshy apricot, melon and enticing plum pastry notes and delicate spice. A perfect balance of freshness and generosity.

Champagne Bollinger Brut NV

Complex developed fruit and biscuity aroma and flavours with a long elegant finish.

Champagne Ruinart Blanc de Blancs NV

Ruinart can be described in few words: elegance and refinement.

VINTAGE CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Laurent Perrier Brut Millésimé 2004

A golden yellow colour, with green highlights showing a steady stream of fine and persistent bubbles. The initial aroma is marked by an attractive fruity character which then evolves displaying notes of ripe fruits and honey (acacia honey). Initial impressions are of vivacity and a fine mousse. As its character is gradually revealed, there is a sense of complexity, depth of flavour and a still youthful freshness. The long finish is marked by persistent notes of yellow stone fruits (mirabelle plum).

Champagne Taittinger Brut Millesimé 2005

Pale yellow colour with bright fine bubbles. On the nose it is elegant and fresh and light. Slightly vegetal, it is extremely flowery and has tealeaf aromas. On the palate, this wine is initially harmonious and lively, then fruity with flavours of white peaches, kiwi and mango. On the finish it has great finesse and length.

ROSE CHAMPAGNE

Veuve Fourny 1er Cru Rosé NV

From hand-picked Pinot Noir grapes from Vertus Premier Cru, this cuvée is the fruit of the traditional Veuve Fourny methods : manual handling, long maceration... With a slight touch of Chardonnay, the Pinot Noir reveals its subtlety on the nose : red and black fruit, with a great freshness in the mouth.

Billcart Salmon Rosé NV

Its pale and bright pink colour is adorned with warm glints of gold and its delicate slowly rising bubbles give it a persistent mousse. This cuvée unveils a subtle aroma leading to an elegant, delicate bouquet of fine notes of red fruits and zest of citrus fruits. Its special method of vinification gives this cuvée a light, elegant flavour, followed by a fresh finish with a taste of raspberry.

Laurent Perrier Rosé NV

Pale cherry-red in colour with a rich blackcurrant and raspberry nose. The palate is elegant and lengthy, with soft, consistent bubbles, ripe red fruits such as raspberries and strawberries, and a clean, soft finish with a creamy texture.

WHITE WINES

OLD WORLD

Pinot Grigio Quecus, Collio Goriziano, Slovenia 2011

A concentrated Pinot Grigio with aromas of ripe pear, grapefruit and pineapple. Poised, medium-bodied palate with a silky, refreshing finish.

Viognier de la Chevalière, Laroche, South of France 2011/12

Light gold in colour with fragrant aromas of orange blossom and spice touches. Delicate apricot and white stone fruit character on the palate with a lingering aromatic and fresh finish.

Macon-Villages Caves de Lugny 2012

Clear and shiny yellow, with golden tints in colour. The nose is fresh and intense with notes of fruit and flowers (citrus, white flowers and honey). Flattering and fresh.

Gavi 'La Fornace', Azienda Tassarolo, Piedmont 2011

The wine is really fresh and floral, clean with a pleasant aftertaste of toasted almond and hints of apple and sage.

Sauvignon de Touraine, Domaine Frantz Saumon, Loire Valley 2011

With wet stones in the nose, green apples and citrus, and soft yet lively acidity, this sauvignon blanc has pristine finesse.

Treixadura, Ailalà, Ribeiro, Spain 2012

Pale gold in colour with lively reflections. There are clean, powerful aromatics on the nose with apricot, white flowers and a sort of saline, sea-shell undertone. Spices such as clove, mint and fennel are also present. The palate displays sweet lemon and ripe melon with plenty of zing and grapefruit peel. A wine of great complexity and style and with bags of character.

Lunas Blanco, Bodegas el Grillo y La Luna, Somontano 2012 (Biodynamic)

Made from the unusual blend of gewürztraminer and chardonnay. The combination of these two varieties, together with 3 months ageing on its lees, make the Doce Lunas a very elegant wine. Of a pale lemon yellow color and intense aromas, it shows notes of peaches and pineapple. The palate is silky, rich, cool, very fragrant and full of body.

Anjou, Chenin, Château de la Roulerie, Loire Valley 2009

Attractively fresh and lemony with a hint of honey in the mid-palate finishing cleanly mineral.

Sancerre Domaine Gérard Fiou 2012

A clear lemon-gold in hue. Very full and expressive on the nose, with notes of grapefruit and greengage, full and plump rather than lean. The palate reveals this to be Sauvignon in the creamy style, but with attractive acidity and a crisp, racy finish.

THE REST OF THE WORLD

Sauvignon Blanc, Viña Mar, Central Valley, Chile 2012

Vibrant and aromatic Sauvignon made by state-of-the-art winery in Chile's Casablanca.

Preludio Chardonnay Viognier, Juanicó, Uruguay 2012

Pale straw colour with a hint of green. Nose: Intense aromas, fruit and oak harmoniously integrated displaying notes of peach, honey, vanilla, cream and nuts. Palate: Well rounded and fresh depicting aromatic notes. Long, rich and butter like finish.

Unoaked Chardonnay, Omrah, Margaret River, Western Australia 2011

A peachy nose, with a twist of lemon and just a hint of creamy yeastiness and minerality. A lovely rich smooth palate of mouth filling flavours with a crisp clean finish to bring the wine into focus. Exudes Chardonnay purity, with both fullness and finesse.

Sauvignon Blanc Le Petit Clos, Marlborough, New Zealand 2012

The nose shows luscious ripe fruit, while the mouth still shows fruit without overdoing it and a pleasant freshness. It keeps a lovely dry finish while showing a great mouthfeel. A wine made to enjoy – without being a fruit salad!

Riesling Wonderland of Eden Valley, Dandelion Vineyard, South Australia 2012

Pristine pale straw with almost fluorescent green tinges. An intense late vintage nose of powerful jasmine, mandarin leaf and even lychee juice bursting fruit freshness, with invigorating, intense smells of lime skin and cinnamon spice. The palate shows a wonderful spectrum of stone-fruit, including apricot and classic mandarin, developing into rich lemon meringue tart-like flavour but still with a refreshing steely minerality, balanced with racy, slate-like acidity.

RED WINES

OLD WORLD

Tempranillo , Solarena, Carinena, Spain 2011

Solarena is ripe in character with spiced raspberry aromas. The enticing brambly fruit on the palate gives way to rounded, velvety, vanilla flavours, while the subtle oak adds extra richness, structure and intensity of flavour.

Beaujolais Villages Vieilles Vignes JC Lapalu 2011

Nice Gamay, fruity and mineral. Nice nose of red fruit, the palate is medium weight with nice tannins.

Tempranillo Avaniel, Ribera del Duero, Spain 2011

This is an abundantly fruity, blackberry-driven red which is chunky and satisfying.

NEW WORLD

Very Sexy Shiraz, Cloof, Darling, South Africa 2012

Exceptionally well-balanced Shiraz that combines freshness with weight, aroma with concentration, and rich blackberry fruit with a spicy, mineral lift. Powerful, characterful, individual wine.

Malbec, Cuatro Manos, Vincent Wallard, Mendoza 2011

A bright violet in colour. Aromas of black cherry and redcurrants. On the palate, earthy and sapid with a minty/herbal edge. Light and bright in texture leading to a short, refreshing finish.

Privada, Bodega Norton, Mendoza, Argentina 2010

Excellent aromatic complexity with notes of ripe fruit, spices, and hints of smoke and coffee. Rich and generous on the palate with superb concentration.

Cabernet-Merlot, Fraser Galop, Margaret River, Western Australia 2010

Striking freshness, reminiscent of pomegranate juice, with hints of eucalyptus and cherry on the nose. The palate offers a mix of red and black fruit, with well judged grip and savoury notes providing balance.

HOUSE WINES

WHITES

La Troubadour Blanc 2012

A classic Southern French white with crisp apple and pear flavours. With a little peachy note at the end, it's a real crowd pleaser.

Acacia Tree Chenin Blanc 2013

A very refreshing and light Chenin Blanc. Shows fresh citrus and peach with exuberant acidity.

Chardonnay Domaine des Templiers, Vin de Pays des Côtes de Thongues 2012

Crisp, ripe wine with refreshingly clean citrus fruit flavours and a rounded finish.

REDS

La Troubadour red 2012

This delicious Southern French blend of Ugni Blanc and Colombard offers up bright, fresh and fruity flavours of peach, pear and passion fruit. This is all complemented with rounded vanilla hints and a refreshing acidity.

Acacia Tree Pinotage

Friendly and approachable with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit and soft rounded tannins.

Pinot Noir, La Bousolle, vin de pays, France 2010

La Bousolle Pinot Noir, from vineyards in the cooler micro-climate of the Oc region, displays ripe strawberry fruit flavours with secondary aromas of French oak and stewed dark fruit. A light and approachable wine with bright acidity and gentle tannins.

ROSES

Réserve de Gassac Rosé, Mas de Daumas Gassac, VdP de l'Hérault 2012

Lively and vivid pink. Pleasant and intense with hints of strawberries. Full and rounded on the palate with aromas of crushed red fruits.
