Exhibitor Benefits

- Display their vehicles in a special area between the American Air Museum and the Land Warfare
- Join the traditional cavalcade around the airfield, including driving along Duxford's historic runway
- Watch tank demonstrations in the arena, after which there will be an opportunity for exhibitors to take their own vehicles around the arena -- at their own risk.
- Ride in an AFV 432 in the morning (£6 per person and per ride). To comply with health and safety regulations the tank ride participant height must be 4 feet 2 inches/128 cm or more).
- Visit the various attractions and activities such as the militaria related trade stands, MAFVA's National Championships and a Military & Aviation Book Fair.

As always, the museum is open for all exhibitors and their guests to enjoy. The show ends at 5pm and the museum closes at 6pm.

Please note: all activities/events/participants are subject to change without notice.

Terms and conditions of exhibiting

- All drivers and vehicles are to be appropriately licensed and insured.
- Vehicles must obey the site speed limits of 5mph on site and for the cavalcade: 25mph on the taxiway and 70mph on the runway. Any drivers not obeying speed limits or instructions from IWM event staff and marshals will be asked to leave the site.
- Vehicle movement: apart from participation in the cavalcade, vehicle movement is prohibited once on site and parked up by marshals
- Firearms and replicas: No live weapons of any type or fashion, no blank firing weapons (machine guns, rifles, pistols etc), no live or blank ammunition, no pyrotechnics (of any type or fashion), no explosives, no propellants (black powder, cordite or other propellants) and no smoke grenades or similar devices are allowed on site. Only deactivated vehicle-mounted firearms/weapons or deactivated weapons as part of a static display will be allowed on site. All deactivated weapons **MUST** have a certificate available for inspection if required on the day. No replicas capable of firing blank charges and/or projectiles are allowed on site. No weapons are to be carried around on the site.
- No Axis uniforms are to be worn on site. There are no restrictions on the wearing of Allied Uniforms. Thank you for your cooperation.
- No dogs are allowed within the site, except assistance dogs. This is a CAA safety precaution for all live airfields.
- No barbecues or gas appliances are allowed on the museum site during the event.
- Gazebo's are not allowed unless they are covered by the owners Public Liability Insurance (a copy must be made available on the day). They must be properly and securely attached to the ground and do not take up a parking space. Guide ropes must be secure and not cause trip hazards. Any stakes must not be longer than 20cm.
- Exhibitors are not allowed to sell items, services or refreshments. If you would like to do so, please book a trade space via the IWM Duxford Trader Coordinator prior to the event.
- IWM reserves the right to request an exhibitor and his/her guest(s) to leave the museum site at their discretion.

Closing dates for entries

- All entries to be received by the Show Secretary before Friday 10 May 2013.
- Entries received after this date will not be processed and applicants will need to register on the day of the show. A 2013 show plaque cannot be guaranteed. On the day registration excludes listing in the event programme.
- All exhibitors registering on the day will be subject to an administration charge of £7.50 per entry.
- Gate passes and information will be sent out approximately two weeks before the show.
