Rules:

- **Camping on site:** If groups want to camp in their display areas, the tents must be in keeping with the event theme. No modern vehicles or equipment are permitted next to display areas during event opening hours. We do have a small area on our North side of site where all non-period tents or vehicles can be left for the duration of the event. Camping forms are sent out prior to the event for completion.
- **Deactivated and/or replica weapons on site:** These must be always kept within your display areas. All certificates and proof of replica documentation must be sent to the event organiser before the event.
- **Dress:** All participants must be in period dress whilst the museum is open to visitors over the event day(s).
- **Vehicle movements on site:** No vehicle movements are permitted when the museum is open to the public unless they are part of a display/re-enactment and have been authorised for movement by the event organiser or in response to an emergency.
- **Please note:** event opening times for individual flying events and air show weekends vary. All information will be sent to group leaders in a welcome pack to share with their group ahead of arrival to site.
