
Part 1 of this form replaces the landing card normally completed on arrival in the UK and completion is compulsory [for all non-EU/EEA nationals].

Part 2 of this form contains the information usually necessary to enable the UK Border Agency to decide your application for leave to enter. Completion of Part 2 is voluntary but is necessary for remote immigration clearance.

Once the completed form has been passed to the UK Border Agency, your application for leave to enter will be considered. The form will then be endorsed with the appropriate conditions and returned to the airfield operator, who will hand the form to you.

Please note Your passport will not be stamped and this form should be retained at all times whilst in the UK, as evidence of your permission to enter the UK.
