## Immigration Clearance to Enter the United Kingdom (UK)

Certain persons wishing to enter the UK require immigration permission ("leave to enter") to enter lawfully and stay in the UK. Where permitted by Border Force a person may use this form to apply for leave to enter the UK.

You are required to complete Part 1, Part 2 and sign and date the declaration of the form. You should not complete part 3 of the form. You should submit the form to the Border Force office which sent it to you. Forms submitted prior to arrival will not be considered until you have arrived in the UK. On receipt of the form Border Force will consider your application and may contact you by telephone. If Border Force grants you leave to enter the UK, this form will be appropriately endorsed and returned to you. Your passport will not be stamped. You should retain the form at all times with your passport as evidence of your immigration permission to enter and stay in the UK.

You should not leave the airfield/airport until you have received an endorsed form from Border Force or been advised by a Border Force Officer you may leave. If you fail to do so and are not a British Citizen or a national of an European Economic Area member state you could be committing a criminal offence.
